In 1984, Barbara and her husband Eddie "Pop Pop" Ferrentino co-founded Ferrentino & Son, LLC, a family-operated construction company rooted in quality, integrity, and community. Over the decades, Barbara has been a mentor and leader, guiding others in the trades and encouraging excellence, especially among young women entering the field. She has remained actively involved in Women Build, and we are beyond grateful that she returned to help us launch this new chapter. And now... she's passing the torch. We are so proud to introduce her daughter-in-law, Shawna Ferrentino, who is leading her own Women Build team: Ferrentino's Fierce Females. Shawna has been one of our strongest supporters—even before this year's campaign began—and we look forward to building alongside her.



FREEWILL

Everyone should make a will or living trust, regardless of wealth. Having a plan in place ensures that your agents and loved ones know your wishes and saves them the stress of costly court proceedings.

With a valid will or trust, you can choose who gets your property, name guardians for your minor children, provide a home for your pets, and more. It only takes 20 minutes, and you can update your documents at any time if your plans change.

Habitat for Humanity of Marion County has partnered with FreeWill to offer all our supporters the chance to create a legally valid *will* online, completely **free of charge**.

FreeWill takes less than 20 minutes to complete and generates a will that is valid in all 50 states, making it easy for you to start your legacy with Habitat. You can use this resource independently or document your wishes before finalizing your plans with an attorney. If you have a more complex estate, FreeWill can help you compile a list of documented wishes to take to your attorney's office.



Did you know?



- Having a valid will in place isn't enough.
- Assets you pass on outside of your will are called non-probate assets. They include lRAs, 401(k)s, pensions, life insurance policies, and certain bank and brokerage accounts.
- If beneficiaries are <u>properly set for these non-probate assets</u>, ownership can transfer faster than your assets that must go through probate.

Thanks to FreeWill, you can easily plan beneficiaries for your non-probate assets in one place.
